Connexionz Wins Newbury RTI contract.

West Berkshire Council have awarded Connexionz UK, the Crawley based RTI supplier, the contract for its trial Newbury RTI project.

The project will start with a trial route, and will provide bus units on 10 buses and 5 of Connexionz new high spec TFT screens on the street. One of the buses will act as a trial for the Vodaphone services serving their Head office, and expansion may follow once Connexionz have proved what they can do.
